Field Trip to BODIES...The Exhibition and TITANIC: The Artifact Exhibition

Self-Guided Tours for School Groups

This tour allows teachers, students, and chaperones to tour the Exhibition on their own during Exhibition hours. Artifact specialists and medical docents may be available within the galleries to answer questions. Guided tours are not available. Please feel free to plan extra time for students to explore our souvenir shops after the visit.

Estimated Duration: 1-2 hours per Exhibition

One Exhibition:
